Which was read and adopted:

By the Senate,

March 15, 1834.

Gentlemen of the house of delegates,

We have received your message proposing to invite His Excellency, the Governor, in the Senate Chamber this evening, at 5 o'clock, for the purpose of signing the laws, and beg leave to suggest the hour of 10 o'clock, P. M. in place of the hour named by you.

We have appointed Messrs. Morris, and Wilson, on the part of the Senate to join the gentlemen named by you.

Was read the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

The resolution requiring the geologist appointed by act of assembly to make a survey of the state, to deposit the specimens he may collect in certain literary institutions.

Was read the third time, assented to, and sent to the house of delegates.

The following bills which originated in the senate,

Were severally read by their titles, and referred to the consideration of the next general assembly.

The bill entitled, an act to extend to the high court of chancery, and the several county courts, sitting as courts of equity, jurisdiction in cases of divorce.
