Gentlemen of the Senate,

We return you the bill entitled, an act making it penal to sell certain property under certain circumstances, and respectfully ask a reconsideration.

The facts which have been presented to us, call loudly for legislative interference. Slaves have been replevied out of the possession of their rightful owners and sold to foreigners, by persons having no colour of title to the property, and thus deprive their owners of all possibility of regaining their property, as the present law contemplates; we therefore hope your honorable body will pass the bill.
