

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution in favor of Louis Gassaway. Also

A resolution in favor of David Ridgely,
Which were severally read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

Also the following bills:

A bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act passed at December session 1832, to incorporate the Fell's Point Savings Institution.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Morris and Pigman.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Howard Beneficial Society of Maryland.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Morris, Mayer and Montgomery.

And returned the bill which originated in the senate, entitled, a further supplement to the act, entitled, an act to authorise the making a general alphabetical index of the land records of Baltimore county, from the year 1799, inclusive, and to keep up such index henceforth, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments."

Which amendments were read the first time and were as follows:

1st. In the 2nd section, and third line, after the word "supplement," insert the words "and of the supplement to said act, passed at December session in the year eighteen hundred and thirty three."

2nd. In the 2nd section and 14th line, after the word "respectively," insert the words, "as provided by the first section of the act to which this is a further supplement"

Mr. Pigman from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the relief of Joshua B. Iiams, of Anne Arundel county, reported, that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was read the second time.
