

The ballot box was prepared, and the ballots deposited therein, and on examination thereof by the clerk, it appeared there had been 9 votes given, all of which were for Mr. Chapman.

Whereupon it was declared, that the Hon. John G. Chapman is unanimously elected President of the Senate. He accordingly took the chair.

The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The President laid before the Senate a letter from John S. Martin, Esquire, a member elect of the council, communicating his acceptance of the appointment.

Which was read and referred to the consideration of the house of delegates.

Mr. Pigman from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the relief of the German Reformed and Lutheran Congregation of Salem Church, in Boonsborough, Washington county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings to which was referred the petition of Alfred Y. Clagett, and others, reported a bill entitled, an act relating to the division of Hezekiah Clagett's estate.

Which was read the first and by special order the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act passed at December session 1832, to incorporate the Fell's Point Savings Institution, reported, that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to.

Strike out all the bill after the enacting clause, and insert:

“That at the next election for directors of the corporation created by the act to which this is a supplement, and annually thereafter, the members shall elect ten directors, instead of five only, as provided by said act, to manage the affairs of said corporation; and that all the provisions of said act respecting said five directors and the election thereof, be and the same are hereby
