A resolution in favour of Thomas E. Martin, assented to by the Senate on yesterday,

The bill, entitled, An act, to confirm an act, to amend the constitution and form of government, as relates to the division of Somerset county, into election districts, and to establish an additional district.

The bill, entitled, An act, to provide for the opening and extension of Currant's Alley, in the city of Baltimore,

And the bill, entitled, An act for the revaluation of the real and personal property, in Frederick county.

Severally passed by the senate on yesterday, were returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Wilson from the committee to which was referred the bill, entitled, An act, to provide for building a public bridge across Lawe's Thoroughfare in Somerset county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments.

Which were read and assented to:

Sec. 2. 7th line after word "bond" insert, "to the Levy Court," next line strike out "the commissioners," and insert "Levy Court."

Sec. 5th. 4th line, after the words "levy the same," insert "provided the sum does not exceed two thousand dollars."

Next line, after the word "collector" insert, "on the requisition of the levy court:"

Add to this section the words:—

"When the bridge shall be finished, and the same shall have been received by the levy court."

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.
