Was read the second time by special order and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Emory from the committee on colored population to which was recommitted the bill, entitled, An act, to repeal an act, passed at December session, 1833, chapter 111, reported that the committee had had said bill again under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment:

Which was read the first time,

In the 5th line after the word “repealed” add: “except so far as the same relates to the counties of the Eastern Shore.”
