

And the bill, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, An act, to confirm an act, to alter and repeal all such parts of the constitution and form of government as relates to the division of Frederick county, into twelve election districts, and for other purposes, passed at December session 1831, chapter 112.

Also severally passed by the Senate on Saturday, with certain amendments were returned to the House of Delegates.

The President laid before the senate a communication from the Secretary of the Washington and Baltimore Turnpike road company.

Which was read and referred to the consideration of the house of delegates.

Mr. Sappington presented the memorial of sundry citizens of Emmitsburg district in Frederick county, praying the suppression of the Lottery System, within the limits of this state.

Which was read and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Mayer presented the petition of Elizabeth and Robert M. Denison, for leave to bring certain negroes into this state.

Which was read and referred to the committee on colored population.

Mr. Mayer presented the petition of Stephen Rossel, in behalf of the Baltimore Annual Conference, praying the incorporation of trustees for preserving an education fund, now applied to the support of Dickerson College.

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Forrest and Wootton.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the following resolutions:

A resolution in favor of John Stalker

Which were severally read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

Also the following bills:

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington Forrest and Mayer

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Anne Arundel county, to sell certain property therein mentioned.
