It was determined in the affirmative, and the bill return-

ed to the House of Delegates.

The bill entitled, An act, to make valid the partition of certain real estate lying in Frederick county, in conformity with the provisions of a certain deed made and executed by and between Henry Clagett and Julia Clagett his wife of the one part and Grafton Duvall and Elizabeth W. Duvall, his wife, of the other part, hearing date the twenty fith day of June, in the year of our Lord 1821, and recorded in Liber I.S. No. 13 folio 545 and 6, one of the land records of Frederick county,

Was read the third time, passed, and returned to the

House of Delegates.

The bill entitled, a further supplement to an act, entitled, An act, to establish a Bank in the city of Balti-

more, to be called the city Bank of Baltimore,

And an act, entitled, a supplement to an act, to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road, leading to Cumberland, and for the extension of the charters of the several Banks in the city of Baltimore, and for other purposes,

Was read the third time and passed.

On motion of Mr. Wootton,

The bill entitled, An act relating to issues from Orphans' Courts, was made the order of the day for Fri-

day next, the 6th February.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which the leave was granted reported a bill, entitled, a further supplement to the act, entitled, An act, directing the manner of suing out attachments in this Province and limiting the extent of them,

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Morris from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a further supplement to the act, entitled, An act, for the opening of Pratt Street Wharf in the city of Baltimore, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was read the second, and by special order the third

time and rejected.

The Senate adjourned until Monday morning 10 o'clock.
