In the 4th line of the 4th section, strike out all the

section after the word "districts."

The bill was then read the second, and hy special order the third time, passed, and returned to the House

of Delegates.

Mr. Sappington, from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, A further supplement to the act entitled, an act to provide for the election of Commissioners for Washington county, and prescribing their powers and duties, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the House of Dele-

gates.

Mr. Morris, from the rommittee on finance, to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled. An act specifying certain duties to the treasurer of the Western Shore, in relation to Banks,

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Hughlett, from the committee on revolutionary claims, to which was referred the resolution in favor of Henry Cook, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, assented to, and returned to the House of Dele-

gates.

Mr. Wootton, from the committee to which was reterred the bill entitled, An act to open and make public a road from Cole's Warehouse to St Aloysius chapel in St. Mary's county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

On motion of Mr. Morris,

The Senate proceeded to consider the amendments proposed by the House of Delegates to the bill entitled, An act to authorise the appointment of a Commissioner of Loans.

The said amendments were read, and severally agreed

to, except the following:

In the 7th line of the 3d section, after the word "the," insert "Governor and Council, for the time being, shall approve, which bond shall be deposited with the treasurer of the Western Shore."

The question was put,

"Will the Senate agree to said amendment?"
