

On motion of Mr. Pigman,
Read the third time by special order, assented to,
and sent to the House of Delegates.

On motion of Mr. Mayer,
The bill entitled, A further supplement to the act
entitled, an act relating to Insolvent Debtors, in the
city and county of Baltimore,
Was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. Morris,
The following amendment was read and assented to:
At the end of the 1st section, add,
“ Provided, That nothing herein contained shall be
so construed as to effect property, that may have pass-
ed for a *bona fide* consideration, into the hands of third
persons.”

The question being on the engrossment of said bill,
It was accordingly put, and
Determined in the affirmative.

The bill entitled, An act relating to manumissions,
Was read the second time, and

On motion of Mr. Emory,
Ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Morris,
The resolutions authorising the treasurer of the
Western Shore to withdraw the State's Deposites from
the Union Bank of Maryland, and to sell the debt due
the State from the Bank of Maryland, and to apply a
portion of the same to the payment of the expenses of
the current fiscal year,

Were taken up for consideration,

Read the third time, assented to, and returned to the
House of Delegates

Mr. Mayer, from the committee on judicial proceed-
ings, to which was referred the petition of Alexander
Macdonald, and John Ridgely and wife, reported a bill
entitled, an act to authorise Alexander Macdonald,
devised in trust of Nicholas G. Ridgely, to lease and
make sale of certain property therein mentioned,

Which was read the first, and by special order the se-
cond time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Mayer,
Read the third time by special order, passed, and
sent to the House of Delegates.
