Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Claude, Morris and Montgomery.

A bill entitled, An act to change the name of Peace Alley, in the city of Baltimore, to Perry Street,

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs Mayer, Morris and Groome.

And returned the bill, which originated in the Senate, entitled, An act relating to the City Hotel of Frederick, endorsed "will pass, with the proposed amendment."
