Also the following bills:

A bill entitled, An act for the benefit of the securities for the appearance of insolvent debtors within this State,

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

A bill entitled, An act to amend the Declaration of Rights, the Constitution, and Form of Government of this State,

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Emory, Forrest and Pigman.

Mr. Forrest from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, A supplement to the act entitled an additional supplement to the act entitled, an act to reduce into one the several acts of Assembly respecting elections, and to regulate said elections, passed at December session, 1832, chapter 275, reported favourably thereon.

It was read the second time.

Mr. Mayer, from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, An act relative to the selling and removal of negro slaves, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass, with the following amendment,

In the 4th line of the bill after the word "reside" insert "or when said negro shall have been sold or otherwise disposed of."
