

The following amendment was read and adopted:

At the end of the bill, add,

“And provided also, that this act, shall not apply to any cases now pending, nor to real estates of debtors, who shall have departed this life before the passage of this act.”

On motion of Mr. Forrest,

The bill was then ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Groome from the committee to which was referred the bill, entitled, A supplement to an act, to authorise and empower the commissioners of Cecil county to build a bridge over the Big North East Creek, at or near William Phillips's in said county passed at December session 1831, reported, that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to.

Add at the end of the bill:

“And that such commissioner or commissioners so appointed or hereafter to be appointed as the case may be, shall render to the commissioners of Cecil county, a full account of the manner in which such sum of money shall be expended.”

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.
