A bill entitled, An act for incorporating the Deer Park Academy, in Baltimore county,

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Morris, Mayer, and Montgomery.

A bill entitled, A supplement to an act entitled, an act appointing commissioners to build a bridge over the Little Falls of Gunpowder, in Harford and Baltimore counties, passed at December session, 1831, chapter 101,

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Montgomery, Mayer, and Pigman.

A bill entitled, An act to divorce Mary Anne Roache, of the city of Baltimore,

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on divorces.

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, An act specifying certain duties to the treasurer of the Western Shore, in relation to Banks, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendment,"

Which amendment was read, and adopted, and was as follows:

After the word 'circulation' in the 1st section, 12th line insert the following, 'specifying the amount of the different denominations of issues.'

Also returned the following bills; which originated in the Senate, severally endorsed "will pass."

The bill entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act relating to the city of Baltimore, passed at December session 1817, chapter 148,

The bill entitled, An act to authorise Alexander MacDonald, devisee in trust of Nicholas G. Ridgley, to lease certain property therein mentioned.

Mr. Wilson from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, An act for the repair and improvement of a portion of the public road in Worcester county, reported favorably thereon;

It was the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of Delegates.

Mr. Pigman from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, An act to establish a Market, and build a Market House in the town of Cumberland, in Allegany county, and for the regulation of the same, reported that the committee had had said bill under con-
