4. In the 7th line 1st section before the word "descendants" insert the word "lawful."

5. In the 1st line of the title, strike out the word "and," and after the word "Barrett," same line insert "Moses Coker and Charles Williams,"

6. In the title, after word "Dorchester" insert "Harford, Caroline."

The bill was then read through and passed.
