Which were severally read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

A bill entitled an act for the relief of James B. Collins, of Caroline county,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on insolvency.

A bill entitled, An act to authorise the commissioners of Anne-Arundel county, to sell certain property therein mentioned;

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Claude, Morris and Emory.

A bill entitled, an act to make valid a certain deed executed between Edward H. Calvert and Benjamin Oden, of Prince George's County,
