

Fourth line after the word "fund," strike out "for" and insert "is hereby devoted to,"

Fifth line after the word "state" insert the words, "to be."

*Section 13.*

Sixth line strike out "he may issue," and insert "that shall be issued."

Eighth line strike out the word "Canal."

*Section 17.*

Add at the end of the section these words, "after the acceptance of the provisions of this act by the stockholders of the Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Road Company, in the form and manner provided, the state shall be entitled to three additional directors, to be appointed by the Governor and Council, shall be citizens of this state."

*Add, section 21.*

Twenty-first section, And be it enacted, That whenever the treasurer is required to decide any legal question under the provisions of this act, that he is hereby authorised to consult such learned council as he may think proper or advisable.

Twenty-second section. And be it enacted That the act entitled, "A further supplement to an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Road Company," passed at December session 1832, chapter 220, be, and the same is hereby repealed.
