

Resolution directing him to furnish the county court of Worcester with the Maryland Reports, received and referred 325, favorably reported on, assented to and returned to the House of Delegates 329-30.

Library. Message received, proposing the appointment of a joint committee to carry into effect the several enactments relative thereto 8. Message returned, concurring 42.

Resolution relative to the works presented by the British Government to, received and referred 307, favorably reported on, assented to and returned to the House of Delegates 312-13.

Licenses. Leave to report a bill relating to for the sale of spirituous liquors, granted and referred 329-30, bill reported 239, amended and ordered to be engrossed 307, passed, and sent to the House of Delegates 317-18, returned "will not pass," 340. Message, with the bill sent back to the House of Delegates, asking reconsideration 345, returned "will not pass" 360.

An additional supplement to an act to regulate the issuing of, to traders, keepers of ordinaries and others, passed at December session 1827, chap. 117, received and referred 296, favorably reported on, passed and returned to the House of Delegates 302.

Liens. Memorial of sundry builders, praying that the bill for securing liens to mechanics may not pass, received and referred 236. See Mechanics.

Light Street. A bill increasing the width of, in the city of Baltimore, received and referred 237, favorably reported on 264, passed and returned to the House of Delegates 276.
