

Roads. A bill received to lay out and open a road in Cecil county, referred 43, favorably reported on 44, recommitted 49 50, unfavorably reported on, rejected and returned to the House of Delegates 297.

Petition of sundry citizens of Cecil county, counter to the petition for opening a road in in Cecil county, received and referred 50.

A supplement to the act to lay out and open a road in Cecil county, passed Dec. session 1832, received and referred 79, favorably reported on, passed and returned to the House of Delegates 144.

A bill received to make public a certain Road in Baltimore county, referred 46, unfavorably reported on, rejected and returned to the House of Delegates 53.

Memorial of John Glenn and Hugh Davey Evans, praying the licensing of the Franklin Turnpike Road, presented and referred 44, bill reported relating to 48, amended and ordered to be engrossed 192, passed and sent to the House of Delegates 194, returned passed 317.

A bill received to open and locate a new road in Allegany county, referred 69, reported amended 87-8, passed and returned to the House of Delegates 103-4.

Petition of sundry inhabitants of Allegany county, praying the passage of a law authorising the construction of a Rail Road, from the mines to the nearest point on the Potomac River, received and referred 79, bill reported to incorporate the Maryland Stone Coal Rail Road Company 109, rejected 358, counter memorial received and referred 125.

A bill received to authorise commissioners to lay off a road from William Dorsey's, at Back Creek in Somerset County, to the county road, referred 76,
