

*Senator of the United States.* Message received proposing to go into the election of 21; message returned concurring 29; message received nominating 30. Robert H. Goldsborough elected 31; message sent to the House of Delegates proposing that a joint letter from the President of the Senate, and Speaker of the House, be forthwith forwarded to him by express, informing him of his election 31, message received concurring 32.

Resolution authorising the Governor to issue a commission in the usual form to the Honorable Robert H. Goldsborough as Senator to represent this State in the Congress of the United States, to supply the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of the Honorable Ezekiel F. Chambers, sent to the House of Delegates 36, returned assented to 37.

*Shaaff Charles S.* A bill received to make valid a certain deed to, of Allegany County, referred 217, reported amended 282, passed and returned to the House of Delegates 282.

*Shaaf, James.* Resolution received in favor of Isaac Swartzwalter, James Shaaf, Ignatius P. Lyles, George Monoly and Patrick Donnelly, referred 224, favorably reported on, and assented to 266-7, returned to the House of Delegates 268.

*Skafer, Henry and others.* A bill received to authorise them to distribute their estate by lot, referred 108, favorably reported on 153, passed and returned to the House of Delegates 156.

*Shaw, Elizabeth Ellen.* A bill received to alter and change the name of Ellen Ambrose, to Elizabeth Ellen Shaw, referred 69, reported favorably on, passed and returned to the House of Delegates 197.

*Shaw, Moses.* A bill received for the benefit of Francis Martin and Moses Shaw, referred 236, unfavorably reported on 244, rejected
