

Mr. Emory from the committee to which was referred the petition of Ezekiel F. Chambers, and Sarah G. Chambers, reported a bill entitled, An act to confirm a deed therein mentioned,

Which was read the first, and by special order the second time, and ordered to be engrossed,

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Emory,

Read the third time by special order and passed.

Mr. Emory from the committee to which leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, A further additional supplement to an act entitled, an act to reduce into one the several acts of assembly respecting elections, and to regulate said elections,

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Hughlett from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to extend the power of the Commissioners for Talbot county, for the purposes therein named, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to:

In the 3rd line, 2nd section, after the word 'required,' insert the words 'at their discretion.'

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time and passed.

Mr. Emory from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to confirm an act passed December session 1834, chapter 219, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.
