

The bill entitled, an act to extend the power of the Commissioners for Talbot county, for the purposes therein named, also passed by the Senate on yesterday with an amendment,

Was returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Hughlett from the committee on Revolutionary Claims to which was referred the resolution in favor of Alexander Benson Coe, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, assented to, and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Emory from the committee on the Militia, reported a bill entitled, an act for the better regulation of the Militia of the City of Baltimore;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Morris from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to change the name of Thomas Nicholson of Baltimore City to that of Thomas Gould, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time and passed.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following bills:

A bill entitled, An act to authorise Thomas Baldwin present Sheriff of Prince George's county to bond as Sheriff of said county at any time before the thirteenth day of February next, and to authorise the clerk of said county to receive and record said bond.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, An act to amend the Constitution and Form of Government so far as relates to the division of Allegany county into election districts, and to establish an additional election district.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Montgomery, Claude and Pigman.

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act to confirm a deed therein mentioned, endorsed "will pass."

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.
