all that part of the constitution and form of government as relates to the division of Washington county into eight seperate election districts, and for other purposes,

Which was read the first time.

On motion of Mr. Groome,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Groome, Wootton and Montgomery, to prepare and report a bill to be entitled, an act to prevent the destruction of wild fowl in the head waters of the Chesapcake bay, in the several counties therein mentioned.

On motion of Mr. Page,

The bill entitled, a further supplement to the act for quieting possessions, enrolling conveyances and securing the estates of purchasers,

Was read the third time by special order, passed and

sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer presented the memorial of James Bosley, of the city of Baltimore, praying that provision be made for his indemnification in the event of the extension of the Pennsylvania and Susquehanna Canal into Maryland, on the western side of the river Susquehanna,

Which was read and referred to the committee on inter-

nal improvement.

On motion of Mr. Mayer,

Leave was granted to the committee on judicial proceedings, to prepare and report a bill to be entitled, an act relating to the jurisdiction and powers now vested in justices of the peace for the city of Baltimore.

On motion of Mr. Mayer,

It was ordered, that there be printed 500 copies of the reports of the Engineer and Geologist on the new map of

Maryland.

The Senate proceeded to consider the bill entitled, an act to alter and amend an act providing for the appointment of Lime Inspectors for the city of Baltimore, and prescribing their duties,

It was being read the third time, when

On motion of Mr. Wootton,

It was ordered to lie on the table.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the following resolutions:

A resolution in favor of the commissioners of Anne Arundel county, and

A resolution in favor of Thomas F. Bowie,

Which were severally read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.
