Delegates.

The bill entitled, an act to confirm an act, passed at December session 1834, entitled, an act to repeal all that part of the constitution and form of government as relates to the division of Washington county into eight separate election districts and for other purposes, was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Groome from the committee on divorces to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to divorce Susan Stewart of Charles county, from her husband John W. Stewart, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to:

At the end of the bill add:

"Nor shall she be entitled, to any property which he may hereafter acquire."

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Groome from the committee on divorces to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to divorce James Al-
