The bill entitled, an act to confirm an act passed at December session 1884, entitled, an act to repeal all that part of the constitution and form of government as relates to the division of Washington county into election districts, and for other purposes,

Was read the third time by special order, passed and

sent to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Mayer,

Leave was granted to the committee on judicial proceedings to prepare and report a bill to be entitled, an act to authorise John McTavish of Baltimore, to act as Trustee in the case therein mentioned and to hold land as tenant by the courtesy.

Mr. Claude from the committee on the Library, to which was referred the resolution to allow to ex-members of the Council, free access to the Library, reported that the committee had had said resolution under consideration and were of opinion it ought to be assented to, with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to.

The resolution was then read the second and by special order the third time, assented to and returned to the House

of Delegates.
