the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and adopted:

In the 4th line of the 2nd section, strike out the word "anuually," and in the same line after the word "incurred," insert "the then succeding year"

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time passed and returned to the house of dele-

gates.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.

## SATURDAY, February 20th, 1836.
