It was read the second and by special order the third time dissented from and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Pigman from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to lay out and make a public road in Allegany county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

The President announced the orders of the day—being the bill entitled, an act to define and enlarge the powers of courts of equity, and

The bill entitled, an act relating to limited partnerships. The Senate proceeded to consider the bill entitled, an act to define and enlarge the powers of courts of equity.

The amendment heretofore proposed by Mr. Mayer,

was read.

On motion of Mr. Mayer,

The said amendment was amended by inserting the words "in the city of Baltimore" after the words "real estate." where it last occurs.

The question was then put,

"Will the Senate assent to said amendment?"

The yeas and nays were asked for and on taking them they appeared as follows:

So it was determined in the negative.

The question being upon the engrossment of the bill,

On motion of Mr. Mayer,

The 1st section in the 15th line, was amended by inserting the words "giving a day to the grantor of the liens to redeem as provided in cases of sales of mortgaged property" after the words "decree a sale."

Mr. Groome moved to strike out the 6th section,—before

the question was put,

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.
