A bill entitled an act for the relief of Benjamin J. Cole, former Sheriff of St. Mary's County, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill entitled an act to authorize the building a Bridge over the Western Branch of the Patapsco Falls at Sykesville,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on internal improvement.

A bill entitled act to condemn and lay off a lot of ground for a public wharf, at Cedar Hall Landing on the Pocomoke River in Worcester county, and to make public a road therein mentioned,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Wilson, Emory and Page.

A bill entitled, an act to streighten, widen and alter certain streets or roads leading from the Town of Cumberland.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Sappington and Emory.

A bill entitled, an act to repeal the act of 1831; chapter 33, and the act of 1832, chapter 5.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Wilson, Emory and Page.

A bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act for building a bridge over Deer Creek, in Harford county, passed at December session 1832, chapter 136.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Montgomery, Page and Wilson.

A bill entitled, an act to repeal all such parts of the constitution and form of government as relates to the division of Cecil county into four seperate election districts.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Groome, Montgomery and Mayer.

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act relating to the grading of streets in the city of Baltimore, endorsed "will pass"
