

Mr. Groome from the committee on divorces to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to divorce Susan Foreman of Queen Anne's county, from her husband John S. Foreman, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to:

Strike out all after the enacting clause and insert in lieu the words following.

That from and after the passage of this act, Susan Foreman of Queen Anne's county, be and she is hereby divorced from bed, board and mutual cohabitation with her husband John S. Foreman.

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Pigman,

The bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Town Hill Mining, Manufacturing and Timber Company, was read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates
