

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

Also the following Bills:

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Hamilton Bank,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

A bill entitled, an act to fix the compensation of jurors, commissioners of the tax, judges of the orphan's court, and justices of the levy court in Kent county,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Osborn, Hughlett and Emory.

And returned the following bills which originated in the senate severally endorsed "will pass."

The bill entitled an additional supplement to the act, entitled an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road company, and

The bill entitled an act to cause the defective acknowledgment of a deed from Henry Roberts and Anne his wife to Lydia Farquhar then Lydia Hatton.

On motion of Mr. Pigman,

Leave was granted to Messrs: Pigman, Sappington and Hughlett, to prepare and report a bill to be entitled an act to incorporate the Cumberland Hotel Company in Cumberland.

On motion of Mr. Sappington,

The committee on engrossed bills was enlarged by adding thereto, the names of Messrs. Emory, Claude, Osborn and Wootton.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled a supplement to an act entitled an act to incorporate the Susquehanna Canal Company, passed at December Session 1825, chapter 200,

Which was read the first time.

The bill entitled an act relating to Indexes of Judgment of Baltimore county court and of records of deeds of land in said county, and for other purposes, was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading,

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Morris,

Read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.
