

Add the following section:

Section 8. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act contained shall be construed to revive the provisions of the 7th section of the act to which this is a supplement.

On motion of Mr. Mayer,

The bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Vulcan Mining and Manufacturing Company of Maryland, was read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

The president announced the order of the day, being the bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act relating to free negroes and slaves, passed at December session 1831, chapter 323, and to alter the 1st section of the said act.

The bill was read the second time, and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Mayer,

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Susquehanna and Patapsco Canal company, passed at December session 1823, chapter 200, was read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Morris, from the committee on finance, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to impose a tax upon theatrical exhibitions, license to travelling menageries, and public shows of every description, within this State, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, rejected, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Claude, from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Battle Creek Academy, in Calvert county; and

The bill entitled, an act for the benefit of George Weems and others, reported favorably thereon.

They were severally read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Claude, from the committee on the library, to which was referred the resolution relative to the public documents, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.
