

A bill entitled a supplement to an act, entitled an act, entitled, an act to provide for public instruction of Youth in Primary Schools throughout this State, passed at December, 1825, chapter 162, so far as relates to Montgomery county,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Mayer, and Hughlett.

A bill entitled an act for increasing the width of Ruxton Lane in the City of Baltimore and to change the name of the said Lane,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Hughlett and Mayer.

A bill entitled an act for the benefit of the infant children of William Riley late of Kent county, deceased.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Osborne, Emory and Sappington.

A bill entitled an act, incorporating the Presbyterian Congregation of Frederick city, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Pigman and Claude.

And returned the bill which originated in Senate, entitled an act to incorporate the Eastern Shore Rail Road Company, endorsed, will pass with the proposed amendments,"

Which amendments were read and adopted and were as follows:

1st. In 13 sec. and 21st line, strike out the words "Sinepuxent Bay and on"

2nd. In same sect. 22 line, after the word "therewith" insert the following, "not within the limits of Worcester county:"

3d. Insert as an additional section.

"And be it enacted, That if in the construction of either of the said rail road or roads, it shall be found necessary to cross any one or more of the water courses, in any one more of the counties through which the same may pass, it shall be the duty of the President and Directors of the said company, to provide a sufficient opening or draw in the deepest part of the channel so as to afford a convenient passage for vessels going up or down the said water course, as the case may be and the said president and directors for the time being, shall provide for the admission of vessels to pass through the said opening or draw without unreasonable delay, or interruption, for which no reward shall be demanded or received, and in
