

And be it enacted, That the Union Company shall at no time charge more toll upon their lock and dam navigation or canal than is now charged upon the Chesapeake and Ohio canal, nor more than one cent per mile a ton for all coal or merchandise transported upon their rail road or roads, nor more than two cents per mile for each passenger transported on said rail ways.

The bill entitled an act to authorize John Mactavish to act as trustee in the case therein mentioned, and to hold land as tenant by the courtesy, was read the second time, and

On motion of Mr. Mayer,
Amended as follows:

At the end of the section add,

Provided however, that the provision of this section shall have effect only so long as said Mactavish, shall continue to reside in the United States.

The bill was then ordered to be engrossed for a third reading. The bill was accordingly engrossed; and

On motion of Mr. Mayer,

Read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Pigman, from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the trustees of the Rockville Female Seminary in Montgomery county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

The Senate adjourned until 5 o'clock P. M.
