The bill entitled, an act for the relief of Josias Hawkins, and Margaret Clark Lee, of Charles county, reported favorably thereon.

They were severally read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Emory from the committee on colored population to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorize Michael Wilson to bring into this State certain negro slaves for life.

The bill entitled, an act to authorize Wm. J. Weir of Prince William county, in the State of Virginia, to bring into this State a certain number of negroes.

The bill entitled, an act to authorize and empower Geo. Purnell, a free man of color, to manumit his children.

The bill entitled, an act to authorize Lucien B. Wright to take with him from this State to the State of Alabama or elsewhere, a free colored boy bound to him for a term of service, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

They were severally read the second, and by special order the third time, rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Osborn from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorize the levy court of Kent county, to levy a sum of money on the assessable property of said county, to make a causeway and erect a bridge on the public road leading from Millington to Smyrna near and adjoining the town of Millington, reported favorably thereon.
