Mr. Pigman from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the benefit and relief of the citizens of Worcester county, and all persons concerned in the records thereof, which may have been destroyed by the burning of the court house of said county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Morris from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, an act supplemental to the act entitled, an act relating to persons of color, who are to be free after the expiration of a term of years,

Which was read the first time.
