

Insert as the 4th section, the following:

Sec. 4th. And be it enacted, that the lands and mines of the said S. L. Skinner, John R. Nourse, Charles Williams, Orlando Harriman, John C. Baldwin and F. L. Wilsey, shall constitute a part of said capital stock at such prices as may be agreed upon between them on the one part, and such persons as may be hereafter associated with them, and constitute the aforesaid corporation by subscribing for stock payable in money.

Insert as section 6th the following:

Sec. 6th. And be it enacted, that any company hereafter formed shall have the privilege of passing over the lands of said Allegany mining company, so as to connect any lateral rail road with the rail road or roads of said Allegany mining company, by paying to said company such sum or sums as may be agreed upon by three disinterested persons appointed by the commissioners of the tax of Allegany county to value said damage or damages.

Insert as two last sections the following:

Sec. And be it enacted, that all such parts of this act as relates to the establishment, working or carrying on of mills, mines or manufactories, may be modified or repealed by the legislature of this State, at any time after thirty years from the passage of this act.

Sec. And be it enacted, that this act nor no part thereof shall be so construed as to give to said company any banking privileges.

Also, returned the bill which originated in the senate, entitled, an act to incorporate the Boston and New York coal company, endorsed, 'second amendment receded from.'

Mr. Groome from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to provide for the public instruction of youth in primary schools throughout this State, passed at December session 1825, chapter 162, so far as the same relates to Kent county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments,

Which were read and assented to:

Strike out the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th and 18th sections.

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.
