And be it enacted, That an act of Assembly passed at December Session, 1825, chapter 250, entitled an act relative to out pensions in Charles county and all other acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act, granting pensions by county assessment to indigent persons in Charles, Montgomery, Frederick, Talbot and Kent counties, be and the same are hereby repealed."

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.
