

And be it enacted, that the State of *Maryland* hereby reserves to herself the same powers to amend, alter or annul the charter by this act, or the act to which it is a supplement, granted as the State of *Pennsylvania* reserves to herself by the 14th section of the act entitled, an act to authorize the Governor to incorporate the *Susquehanna Canal Company*, in respect to the charter granted by said act.

The question was put,
