Mr Page from the committee on invalid deeds and defective proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorize the clerk of Cecil county court, to record an instrument of writing therein mentioned, and to make the same valid, and

The bill entitled, an act to authorize the clerk of Baltimore county court to record a deed therein mentioned,

reported favorably thereon.

They were severally read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house

of delegates.

Mr. Page from the committee on invalid deeds and defective proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorize the recording of a deed from James Carroll of Baltimore city, to Robert D. Sewall of Prince George's county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, rejected, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Hughlett from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the relief of Edward C. Council of Talbot county and Wm. Hains of Cecil county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it out to pass with the following amendments:

Which were read and assented to:

After the word 'that' in the first line of the first section, insert the words 'any one of.'

In the second line of first section, after the word 'coun-

ties' insert the word 'respectively.'
