19th line, same section, strike out 'five hundred' and insert 'two thousand.'

21st line, same section, strike out 'five hundred' and insert 'two thousand.'

2nd section, 1st line, strike out 'five hundred' and insert 'two thousand.'

Also, returned the bill which originated in the senate entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Real Estate Bank of Frederick county, endorsed, will pass with the proposed amendment,

Which amendment was read and adopted, and was as follows:

After the word 'in' 9th line, 2nd section, insert the words 'by the sale of bonds or otherwise.'
