was admitted to a voice in that House

Came John Langford of the Isle of Kent Gentle
lady Comyns wife of the next Island who had given a voice
in the Choice of Rector of Philpot Gent to be one of the Bur
gees for the summet of that Island and desired to Re
voke his Voice and to be personally put in the Assembly
and was admitted

Then it was ordered that any member of the
House not appearing at the hours appointed should be
deemed to be absent for every such default but for this
present meeting such as did appear through fault should
be punished the amercement but for the rest which ap
peared not it should stand

Then were read out of the draught of Laws
transmitted by the Lord Proprietor the twelve first Acts
of the said Province and were severally debated by the
House

Between the hours of two and
three in the afternoon of the same
Day Assembled
