

shall be tendered by virtue of this present act shall Wil-
 fully refuse to take the same that then upon such tender
 & Refusal the said Person or Persons so refusing to take
 the Oath shall be imprisoned till the next County Court
 or hundred Court of Kentward if at such Court such Per-
 ty shall upon the second tender refuse again to take the
 said Oath the Party or Parties so refusing shall forfeit and
 lose all his Lands Goods and Chattels within this Province
 to the Lord Proprietary and his heirs and shall be banish-
 ed the said Province for ever except women covert who
 shall be committed only to prison until such times as
 they will take the same Oath

To which end be it further enacted by the Autho-
 rity aforesaid that the Lieutenant General or other chief
 Governour or Governours for the time being of the Province
 or two of the Council or the Secretary of the Province
 for the time being or any Judge sitting in Court or the
 Commander of the Isle of Kent for persons being or that
 shall be in the Isle of Kent shall have full Power to ad-
 minister the said Oath in manner aforesaid according to
 the Intention of this present act this Act to Continue
 till the end of the next Assembly

An Act for the Liberties of the
 People

Be it enacted by the Lord Proprietary of this Pro-
 vince of and with the advice and approbation of the
 Freemen of the same that all the Inhabitants of this
 Province being Christians slaves excepted shall have
 & enjoy all such rights liberties immunities privileges
