

And free Customs within this Province as any native  
 or Born Subject of England hath or ought to have  
 or enjoy in the Realm of England by Force or Virtue  
 of the Common Law or private Law of England/sa-  
 very in such Cases as the same are or may be altered  
 or changed by the Laws and Ordinances of this  
 Province

And shall not be imprisoned nor dispossessed or  
 Dispossessed of their Freehold Goods or Chattels or  
 be Cattel or sold or otherwise destroyed fore judged  
 or punished there according to the Laws of this Pro-  
 vince saving to the Lord Proprietary and to his heirs  
 all his Rights and Privileges by reason of his domina-  
 tion and Signiory over this Province and the people of  
 the same this act to Commence till the end of the next  
 General Assembly

And in Aid for maintaining the  
 Lord Proprietary's title to the Lands  
 of this Province

Be it enacted by the Lord Proprietary of  
 this Province of and with the advice and approba-  
 tion of their Council of the same that no Subject of his  
 Majesty the King of England or of any other So-  
 reign Prince or State shall Obtain procure or accept  
 of any Land within this Province from any So-  
 reign Prince or State or from any Person whatsoever  
 the native owners of the Land accepted other than  
 from the Lord Proprietary or his heirs or some person  
 Claiming under him or them
