

Commodities to be used or expended within the Prov
 or to export any Corn bought of any Indian throughly
 Out of the Province at any time when the Ordinary price
 of Corn in the Province doth not exceed thirty pound
 of Tobacco for a Barrel of Corn any thing in the Act to
 the contrary notwithstanding

An Act for several Oaths to be taken
 by Judges and publick Officers,

Be it enacted by the Said Proprietary of this
 Province by and with the advice and approbation of
 the Freemen of the same that from and after the last day
 of the General Assembly the Lieutenant General of this
 Province for the time being shall before he executes any
 part of his office take an oath in these words following

I A B do swear that whilst I am a member of this Pro
 vince I will bear true faith unto the right Honourable
 Council of this Province I will bear saving my
 allegiance to the Crown of England and the said Prov
 & him and them and his and their due rights and juris
 dictions and all and every of them will and defend &
 maintain to the uttermost of my power the peace and
 welfare of the people I will ever procure as far as I
 may to none will I delay or deny right but equal Jus
 tice will administer in all things to my best Skill accor
 ding to the Laws of this Province. So help me God

And be it enacted by the Authority aforesaid
 that from and after the last day of this Assembly
 every Councillor of State of the said Province before
