

that such Judgment shall be Given in all matters  
 & causes whatsoever is contrary to the Laws of  
 this Province or in default thereof to the Judgments  
 which usually are thought to be Given in the same  
 in like cases by the Justices or Law merchants in  
~~England or in the Admiralty Court of England as~~  
 well as the said Admiralty Judge or Judge's Commiss  
 ioner or Commissioner shall be able to determine.

That all fines for failure of Bonds or recogni  
 tions to the law of the said Proprietary Commissions  
 Owners of subjects and enemies goods found in  
 the open sea or within high water mark, but had  
 any China belonging thereto, and all other pro  
 fits and perquisites due unto Belonging to England  
 to the High Admiralty of England shall be to the use &  
 Profit of the said Admiralty in variance of law.  
 Admiralty to the law of the said Proprietary except  
 where the said Profits or perquisites vary of them  
 otherwise Granted by Law or this Act to Com  
 mittee till the end of the next Assembly  
 An Act for the erecting of a  
 County Court.

Be it enacted by the said Proprietary of  
 this Province by and with the advice and approbation  
 of the Freemen of the same that all Causes of Appeal  
 from inferior Courts and all Causes whatsoever  
 determinable in any Court of Common Law in Eng  
 land and all Causes for Recovery of Legacies of  
 invents & contracts in Causes matrimonial & the
