

And such Judgment shall be Given in all matters
& Causes whatsoever is most agreeable to the Laws of
this Province or in default thereof to the Judgments
which usually are or ought to be Given in the same
or the like Causes by the Custom or Law merchant in
England or in the Admiralty Court of England as
well as the said Admiralty Judge or Judge's Commis-
sioner or Commissioners shall be able to determine.

And all fines forfeiture of Bonds or recogni-
sances to the use of the Lord Proprietary Confiscations
Penalties forfeitures or fines goods found on
any person the sea or within high water mark but had
any Crimes challenging the same and all other pro-
fits and perquisites due and Belonging in England
to the high Admiralty of England shall be to the use &
Profit of the said Admiralty or in variance of an
Admiral to the use of the Lord Proprietary except
where the said Profits or perquisites or any of them
are otherwise Granted by Statute this Act to Conti-
nue till the end of the next Assembly
