accorded upon which such persons may be condemned
for the said crime under the Party present before
him or herself thereof by such manner as the Court shall
appoint the Party for his or her Purgation.

And every person lawfully served and war-
rant to treat the accused as a felon and not as a rea-
sonable doubt the time and place specified in the will
shall send and pay to such officers shall be mentioned
in the will for penalty of not appearing provided
that such Party exceed not one hundred weight of
tobacco and the same Law shall before any other Law
provided that the Penalty of not appearing exceed
one fifty weight of tobacco.

And such judgment shall be given in all
Crimes in this Court as is most agreeable to the Laws
of this Province in defect of such Laws to the Judg-
ment usually Given in the same in the like Causes
in the civil Courts or Courts of Common Law in Eng-
land as now are the Judge shall be able to determine
and yearly on the first Monday in October and after-
wards (unless till March exclusively) shall be
held in County (near at Saint Marys by the chief Ju-
stice or in his absence) by any Commissioner by the
said chief Justice appointed or in default of a Commis-
sioner by the chief Councillor of State at that time
present at Saint Marys who shall in all things
dealing the said Court have and use all the same
Powers and Authorities as are Given and Granted to
the chief Justice in any part of this act this act to
Continue till the end of the next General Assembly
