summary forms of proceeding and trial shall be used  
in this Court in the chancery shall appear or appear  
and the sume or the like judgments shall be given  
in the sume wherein most agreeable to the Laws of this  
Province or otherwise the judgments usually  
Given in the same in the like Cases in the high  
Court of Chancery in England otherwise are most  
agreeable to right reason equity and good Conscience  
without neglecting the Law of this Province near  
as the said Charterhouse Council shall be able to  
determine this act to continue till the end of the  
next General Assembly.
