

· having upwised to performe the laudable Command
 of their Master or Mistris or of their assignes or ser-
 vants neglecting to do the labour which they ought to
 do or injudically complaining against their master
 or Mistris or offending otherwise against their master
 or Mistris and the Servante so offending shall
 be publickly whipped or otherwise corrected by the
 Discretion of the Judge working on servile Labour
 upon the Underlay in other Kynghays published
 agreeing and in the Church to be kept as herby witness
 of necessity to be attested by the Judge and the
 master Mistris or other Freeman offending thereon
 shall forfeit fiftie pound of Tobacco or five shillings
 Sterling for his own default and thirtie pound of
 Tobacco or five shillings Sterling more for the fault
 of any of his servants offending by his Command
 or Comande being fiftie pound of Tobacco or one shilling
 (Wherupon excepted) whereupon it is Prohibited by the
 Law of England without cause of Infirmity to be
 attested by the Judge and the Offender shall forfeit
 to the said Proprietary five pound of Tobacco or
 One shilling Sterling for every such shooting
 of the piece in the whole within half a quarter of
 an hour or of another within by a single Person or
 in a day or wheter within cause of alarm or
 returning an alarm by three Paces and the
 Offender in either of these shall forfeit to the said
 Proprietary ten pound of Tobacco for every person
 so unlawfully shot of & twenty pound of Tobacco
