

Servants refusing to perform the lawful Commands
 of their Masters Mistresses or of their Assignes over-
 seen or neglecting to do the Labour which they ought to
 do or unjustly complaining against their Master
 or Mistresses or offending otherwise against the vic-
 tims Indenture and the Servant so offending shall
 be publicly whipped or otherwise corrected at the
 Discretion of the Judge sitting in service Labour
 upon the Lord's day or other holy days published
 as aforesaid and in the Church to be kept as by witness
 Case of necessity to be allowed by the Judge and the
 Master Mistresses or other Freeman offending therein
 shall forfeit thirty pound of Tobacco or five shillings
 Sterling for his own default and thirty pound of
 Tobacco or five shillings Sterling more for the fault
 of every of his servants offending by his Command
 or Command sent by flash or time of Day or on other days
 that are prohibited (excepted) where it is prohibited by the
 Laws of England without case of Infirmity to be
 allowed by the Judge and the Offender shall forfeit
 to the said Proprietary five pound of Tobacco or
 one shilling Sterling for every such Offence showing
 of this piece in the whole within half a quarter of
 an hour one of another either by a single Person or
 in answer to another without cause of alarm or
 not answering an alarm by three Paces and the
 Offender in either of these shall forfeit to the said
 Proprietary ten pound of Tobacco for every person
 so unlawfully struck of & twenty pound of Tobacco
